Saltaire United Reformed Church is on Victoria Road Saltaire, Bradford. BD18 3LF.

If driving follow the signs to Saltaire Village and not to Salt's Mill (as that directs you to the Mill Car Park which is some distance from the church). The church is next to Saltaire Railway Station. Leaving the station from Bradford or Leeds turn left, left at the junction and the church is on the left. Travelling from the Skipton or Keighley direction turn left at the station exit and the church is on the left.
